1. What is the legal dispute about? What is the court order about?

You enrolled in a Unity health care sharing ministry ("HCSM") plan through Alera Healthcare, Inc. ("Alera"). We at Unity have terminated our relationship with Alera Healthcare, Inc., and have rebranded to OneShare Health, LLC. There is pending legal action in the Superior Court of Fulton County, Georgia between Alera and Unity Healthshare, LLC ("Unity"), concerning the Unity HCSM plans and the central issue is whether Unity or Alera has the legal right to the Unity HCSM plans.

On December 28, 2019, the Court enjoined Alera's plans to transition Unity HCSM members to Trinity Healthshare on January 1, 2019. The Court required Alera to inform Unity HCSM members that the plans were not being transitioned to Trinity at that time, and you may recall receiving that notification.

On April 25, 2019, the Court entered an order granting Unity's motion for an interlocutory injunction and appointing a receiver to oversee Alera's administration of the Unity HCSM plans and plan assets. 2. What is the reason for the dispute between Unity and Alera?

See explanation above. Alera previously served as the third-party administrator of the Unity HCSM plans. In August 2018, Unity decided to terminate its relationship with Alera. This dispute arises out of that termination and the central issue in the legal action is whether Unity (now known as "OneShare") or Alera has the legal right to the Unity HCSM plans. The Court's order, which you can [here](#) contains detailed facts about the dispute between Unity and Alera, we invite you to read that for background and explanation of the dispute.

3. Am I still covered with Alera/Unity?

Yes. If you do not take any action and continue to submit your monthly share amount, you remain covered by your Unity HCSM plan. This plan will continue to be administrated by Alera, and a court-appointed receiver will "have oversight of the Unity HCSM plans and assets (i.e., the member funds that are properly allocated to the Unity HCSM component of member plans) in order to monitor their proper allocation, preserve them and to ensure that member claims are paid consistently with the plan documents." Nothing will change from your perspective at this time, and the Court will decide what happens to the Unity HCSM plans at the conclusion of the litigation.

4. Who is OneShare and why am I being contacted about OneShare?

We at Unity have rebranded as OneShare. You can learn more about us [here](#).

We are contacting you because the Court is allowing us to reach out to the Unity HCSM members about their options to choose to move to another plan and we are reaching out to you to offer you the opportunity to enroll in one of our OneShare HCSM plans. The OneShare HCSM plans are not affiliated with Alera or Trinity in any way. You may be separately contacted by Alera asking you to enroll in Trinity or another plan as the Court is permitting both parties to contact you in this regard.

If you choose to take no action, you will remain in your current Unity HCSM plan, which will be overseen by the court-appointed receiver and will continue to be administered by Alera while the litigation is pending.



It is for you to decide if you prefer to remain in the legacy Unity HCSM plan during the legal action or to change your plan now. We invite you to take a look at OneShare's offerings, which are offered by leaders with extensive experience in the HCSM space.

5. If I switch to OneShare from my current plan, are my Program Sharing Services and Provider Network changing?

6. Will there be a disruption of service?

No. You will be able to choose your OneShare Health effective date, so there will be no lapse in service.

7. What if my claim has not been paid yet?

8. Will my monthly sharing amount (MSA/MSRA) change?

Your monthly sharing amount will be based on the OneShare Health Program you select.

9. Is OneShare affiliated with Alera in any way?

No. OneShare is an entirely separate entity from Alera and not affiliated in any way. Unity, OneShare's predecessor, had a contractual relationship with Alera that was terminated and is now the subject of the legal action that involves your Unity HCSM plan. 10. Is OneShare or Unity affiliated with Trinity Healthshare?

No. Trinity is an entity that was created by executives at Alera and it is our understanding that Alera sells Trinity as an HCMS plan, which would make it a competitor to OneShare.
